INTS Major requirements

- 44 INTS credits
- Core Requirements (3 courses)
 - INTS 1500: Contemporary Issues in the Global Economy
 - INTS 1700: Introduction to International Politics
 - INTS 2975: Global Issues Research Practicum
- Foreign Language Proficiency (equivalent of 2 years)
- Study abroad (up to 13.5 credits)
- Specialization Area (3 courses)
- Electives, Honors Research Methods, second specialization or Internship (5 courses)

 - International Development and Health
 - International Organizations, Security & Human Rights
