Offered in the Fall quarter, the small class size provides an in-depth academic experience that is rigorous and engaging. In addition to developing self-motivated academic passion, students can expect to hone the academic skills essential for successful college work.

Each seminar focuses on one or more of the following academic skills: writing, critical reading and thinking, discussion, argumentation and debate, and information literacy. This program enables students to engage with faculty in the exploration of novel and challenging topics, and lays the groundwork for extraordinary academic and personal growth.

The course plans below are intended to give students an example of how they might complete their degree requirements in four years. All of the required courses are included, but the quarters in which certain courses are taken can vary significantly from student to student.

For the first quarter of the first year, math majors are typically advised to take an FSEM, at least one math course (MATH 1951, or something else depending on [credit earned through examinations](#)) and enough other credits so that the student is enrolled in 16 or more credits total. Those additional other credits may include common curriculum courses, courses in a second major or minor, or electives.

##### ■ WHEN DO I REGISTER FOR CLASSES AND WHAT IS A REGISTRATION TIME TICKET?

Your registration time ticket is the time and date when you can begin to register for classes for a given quarter. You can find your time ticket by logging into [PioneerWeb](#). Log in and navigate to your student tab > Registration (opens a new window) > Prepare for Registration > Select your next term (e.g. Autumn Quarter 2020 in the drop down > Continue > Your registration time ticket will be displayed.

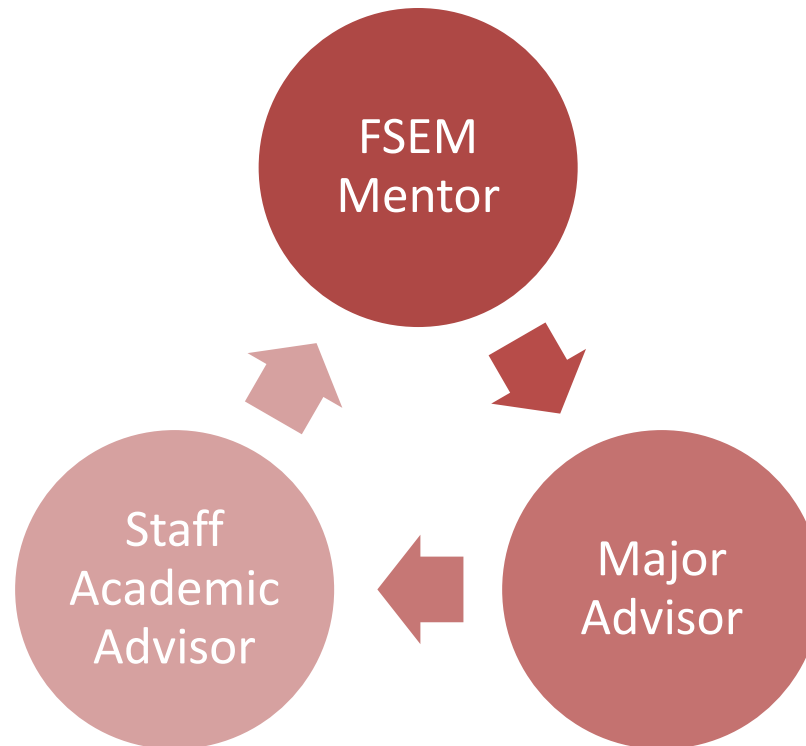
