

Impact of COVID 19 on Campus Shuttle Operations

Changes to Service

1. Cessation of Operations

Due to the suspension of on campus activities, DU ceased all operations of the shuttle on March 13,
2020

2. Resumption of Operations

- With the phased reopening of campus, modified operations resumed on May 11, 2020
- One bus, operating from 8AM to 4PM, Monday through Friday
- Only the On-Demand route is operated
- Fixed route was not resumed
- Though May 22nd there have been five riders



Process and Protocols Implemented

MV Transit Protocols for Addressing COVID 19

At Depot

- Face masks required in building and when on the route
- Supervisors review health checklist with employees at beginning of shift
- · Social distancing enforced in building
- Building is wiped down throughout the day

Vehicle Sanitization

- Cleaning and sanitizing performed each day, at night
- Drivers are issued bottles of sanitizer (spritz) and alcohol wipes to use to sanitize the bus during their shift


On Shuttle Buses

- Hand sanitizer dispensers are installed at the door of the bus
- Seats are blocked to encourage social distancing
- Signage is on buses to remind riders to maintain distancing


Drivers have face masks or coverings
