## Notice of Electronic Posting of Faculty Evaluations of Administrators 2000-2001

Quantitative results of the sixteenth annual Faculty Evaluation of Administrators are available through the Faculty Senate homepage. The evaluation instrument was formulated previously by a committee of the Faculty Senate. It was circulated to all regular faculty, including those designated in University College and The Women's College, Chairs/Directors, Associate Deans, and Deans. The Office of Assessment helped with tabulation of the survey. Narrative comments were transcribed verbatim and delivered to the Provost and the Chancellor. Numeric survey results for those departments/units with five or more faculty are included. For groups with 8 or more responding, the data are presented as average (Avg), standard deviation (StdDev), number responding (n), and median. For groups with fewer than eight responding, the average (Avg) and number responding (n) are published. As in years past, results are not published for units with fewer than five faculty.

This year, 476 surveys were mailed and 189 were returned for a response rate of 40%. The responses are based on the following scale:

- 5 = excellent
- 4 = good
- 3 = average
- 2 = fair
- 1 = poor
