**Synopsis:** On Tuesday, June 11, 2019, a student called Campus Safety with the report of a male exposing himself while in his vehicle. The student stated that the suspect called the student over to his vehicle to ask for directions. Once the student approached the vehicle, it was discovered that the suspect was masturbating. The suspect then drove off.

**Description of Suspect:** Caucasian male with red hair between 20-30 years of age, with a muscular build. He was last seen on South High Street driving northbound in a dark colored truck.

### Safety and Security Tips:

1. Be aware of your surroundings. If you see anyone suspicious, avoid them by entering a public place such as a business.
2. Do not use your phone or any other electronics when walking. These devices distract you and make you an easy target for criminals.
3. Avoid displaying large amounts of cash, or wearing/displaying valuable jewelry or electronics. These items are enticing to criminals who assume that you have more valuables in your possession.
4. Try to walk in well-lit areas as much as possible.
5. Walk on the sidewalk whenever possible. Walk close to the curb, avoiding doorways, bushes and other potential hiding places.
