Synopsis: There has been a spike in thefts of motor vehicles, as well as thefts from motor vehicles, and other personal property on the University of Denver Campus and surrounding off campus areas. The crimes are being committed by a variety of suspects at various times of the day and days of the week.

The Denver Police have been notified and are aware of the reported incidents.

This alert is being sent to increase awareness and promote campus and area safety and security.
