Synopsis: On Wednesday, March 3, 2021, a University of Denver student reported their car, a 2006 Chevy Silverado, stolen. Campus Safety Officers responded to the student at the reported location. The vehicle was later confirmed stolen though recovered.

The victim has been provided resources for law enforcement reporting. This information is being shared with the community per federal law.

Description of Suspects:

5. **When parked, never leave your keys in the car.**
