



Graduation Application Deadlines

- Deadline to apply for Winter Quarter 2022 Graduation – September 20, 2021
Deadline to apply for Spring Quarter 2022 Graduation – January 10, 2022
Deadline to apply for Summer Quarter 2022 Graduation – April 4, 2022
Deadline to apply for Fall Quarter 2022 Graduation – June 20, 2022

Schedule of Deadlines 2021-2022

All forms may be completed and submitted electronically to gradservices@du.edu. We are unable to make exceptions to these deadlines, so please take care to record and meet those that apply.

Fall Quarter 2021

Winter Quarter 2022

Summer Quarter 2022

If degree requirements are not met during the quarter for which the graduation application is entered, the student will be required to delay their graduation to a later quarter and a \$20 delay of graduation fee will be assessed.

\*The completed Schedule of Oral Defense must be scheduled by the candidate and thesis/dissertation director and received in the Office of Graduate Education at least four weeks prior to date of oral defense.

\*\*The thesis/dissertation is due to the oral defense committee at least two weeks prior to date of oral defense.
