Location of Incident: Off Campus, Gravel Pit Bar

Synopsis:

On Friday, January 21, 2022, Campus Safety responded to a student who reported signs of drugging. The student returned home from the Gravel Pit Bar after feeling the symptoms of having been drugged. The student was given an alcoholic beverage by 3 unknown males, not thought to be affiliated with the university. Once the symptoms of drugging began, the student left the bar and shortly after, reported the incident to Campus Safety. While the student declined outside medical services, DUEMS performed an evaluation.

The victim has been provided resources for law enforcement reporting. This information is being shared with the community per federal law.
