# MEDICATION COVERAGE CHANGES



Starting July 1, 2022<sup>1,2</sup>

These are the coverage changes Cigna is making to certain medications as of July 1, 2022.<sup>1,2</sup> Medications are listed alphabetically. Some medications are covered under the pharmacy benefit, some under the medical benefit, and others are covered under both benefits.\* If you're affected by one of these changes, we'll send you a letter with specific information on next steps.

- 1. State laws in **Texas** and **Louisiana** may require your plan to cover your medication at your current benefit level until your plan renews. This means that if your medication is taken off the drug list, is moved to a higher cost-share tier or needs approval from Cigna before your plan will cover it, these changes may not begin until your plan's renewal date. To find out if these state laws apply to your plan, please call Customer Service using the number on your Cigna ID card.
- 2. State law in **Illinois** may require your plan to cover your medications at your current benefit level until your plan renews. This means that if you currently have approval through a review process for your plan to cover your medication, the drug list change(s) listed here may not affect you until your plan renewal date. If you don't currently have approval through a coverage review process, you may continue to receive coverage at your current benefit level if your doctor requests it. To find out if this state law applies to your plan, please call Customer Service using the number on your Cigna ID card.
- 3. This change may not apply to your specific plan. Log in to the myCigna® App or myCigna.com, or check your plan materials, to see if your plan includes prior authorization/precertification, quantity limits, Step Therapy, and/or age requirements.
- 4. If your doctor wants you to continue using this medication, ask your doctor's office to contact Cigna to start the coverage review (prior authorization/precertification) process, or to appeal the denial of coverage. They know how the process works and will take care of everything for you. If you don't get approval by July 1st and continue to fill/order this medication, it won't be covered and you'll pay its full cost out-of-pocket. Also, the cost can't be applied to your annual deductible or out-of-pocket maximum.
- 5. If your plan covers this medication on Tier 4, your cost-share won't change.

Health benefit plans vary, but in general to be eligible for coverage a drug must be approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), prescribed by a health care provider, purchased from a licensed pharmacy and medically necessary. If your plan provides coverage for certain prescription drugs with no cost-share, customers may be required to use an in-network pharmacy to fill the prescription. If customers use a pharmacy that does not participate in your plan's network, the prescription may not be covered, or reimbursement may be limited by your plan's copay, coinsurance or deductible requirements.

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
