## **Administrative Summary**

#### **University of Denver**

This section provides an overview of the CECE graduate survey administration for University of Denver (DU), including details about the administration procedure, recruitment message schedule, the sample, and the response rate. This information can be useful for assessing the data quality and planning for future CECE survey administrations. #### Introduction

During the 2016-2017 academic year, DU worked with the NITE to conduct a school-wide assessment for its graduate students. The purpose of this assessment was to understand how DU cultivates an inclusive, equitable, and supportive campus environment for diverse students. Through analyzing the data collected from the CECE graduate survey, this assessment produces insights regarding the graduate students' perceptions and experiences of the DU campus environments. This report offers a summary of the key findings and recommendations to inform institutional policies and practices that aim to achieve DU's value for "excellence, innovation, engagement, integrity and inclusiveness," as well as DU's mission to "promote learning by engaging with students in advancing scholarly inquiry, cultivating critical and creative thought, and generating knowledge" (University Vision, Values, Mission & Goals, 2017).

#### **Procedures**

The NITE conducted a quantitative assessment through the CECE survey administration. The CECE graduate survey was constructed for graduate student populations and it included 55 items. The survey was disseminated to DU's graduate students between January 17 and April 9 of 2017 through the Qualtrics online survey system. The initial email invitation was sent on January 17, and six weekly reminder emails were sent on February 1, 8, 17, 28, March 7 and 14 to encourage survey participation and completion. DU graduate students who were at least 18 years old and remained the enrolled status during the time of administration were eligible survey participants and invited to participate in the survey. In regard to the survey incentives, DU offered one \$500 Flex spending prize and one \$500 airline voucher to selected student participants who completed and submitted the survey before the survey closure on April 9, 2017. The survey was sent out to 6,191 graduate students, and there were a total of 1,838 responses included in the analysis, which yielded an approximate 30% response rate (please note that this number represents both full and partial completions). The survey data was analyzed to illuminate school-wide perspective and compare views and experiences across subgroups.




# Culturally Engaging Campus Environments 2017 Graduate Survey Frequency Distributions





#### **How CECE Indicator Scores are Computed**

In the CECE Indicator Report, each Indicator score is expressed on an 80-point scale. Component items are converted to an 80-point scale (e.g., for positively worded items, the scale scores would be as follows: Strongly Disagree = 0, Somewhat Disagree = 20, Neither Disagree nor Agree = 40, Somewhat Agree = 60, Strongly Agree = 80), and then averaged together to compute student-level scores. Thus, a score of zero means a student responded at the bottom of the scale for every item in the CECE Indicator, while a score of 80 indicates responses at the top of the scale on every item. Institutional CECE scores are the averages of student-level scores for each group under comparison (e.g., aggregate, racial groups, gender, and enrollment status).

- 1. *Class level:* Two different reports are provided on separate tabs, for Master's students and Doctoral students.
- CECE Indicator statistics: The report displays summary statistics for each of the nine CECE indicators, including mean, number of respondents, and standard deviation.
- 3. Across group comparison: These reports include within-institution comparisons of mean scores for groups of students (for example, across gender, enrollment status, generation status, and race). Please note: several of the student groups have been consolidated.
