Priority Deadlines:

- New students starting in the fall of 2022 should submit the FAFSA by January 15th
- New students starting in the winter, spring or summer of 2023 should submit the FAFSA soon after submitting the admission application
- Returning students should submit the FAFSA by March 15th

Why should I apply by the priority deadline? For new students, applying by the priority deadline means you will receive your financial aid offer around the same time as your admission decision. For returning students, it means you can expect to receive your aid offer in mid-June. If you miss the priority deadline, that's ok—you should still apply as soon as possible so you can receive your aid offer. You won't miss out on funding.
