

Graduate Formal Dual Degree Verification

This form is to be filled out by students pursuing a dual degree listed under the Formal Dual Degree section in the <u>Graduate Bulletin</u>. Students must submit this completed form to the Office of Graduate Education to be acknowledged in a Dual Degree program within the first term of attendance in the **second program**. Students who wish to do a **Flexible** Dual Degree, creating an individualized combined curriculum, must instead submit a proposal for a <u>Flexible Dual Degree</u>.

Dual degrees must be pursued concurrently, not consecutively. In order to meet this requirement, students interested in pursuing a dual degree must be matriculated in both programs for one full academic year (three quarters or two semesters). Students in a one year program must matriculate into the second program no later than the first admission term following fifty percent (50%) coursework completion of the first program.

Students are required to complete both degree programs within five years of matriculation in to the first program. Students must apply for graduation for both programs and both degrees will be awarded at the same time. The full formal dual degree policy can be found <u>here</u>.
