ELECTIVES

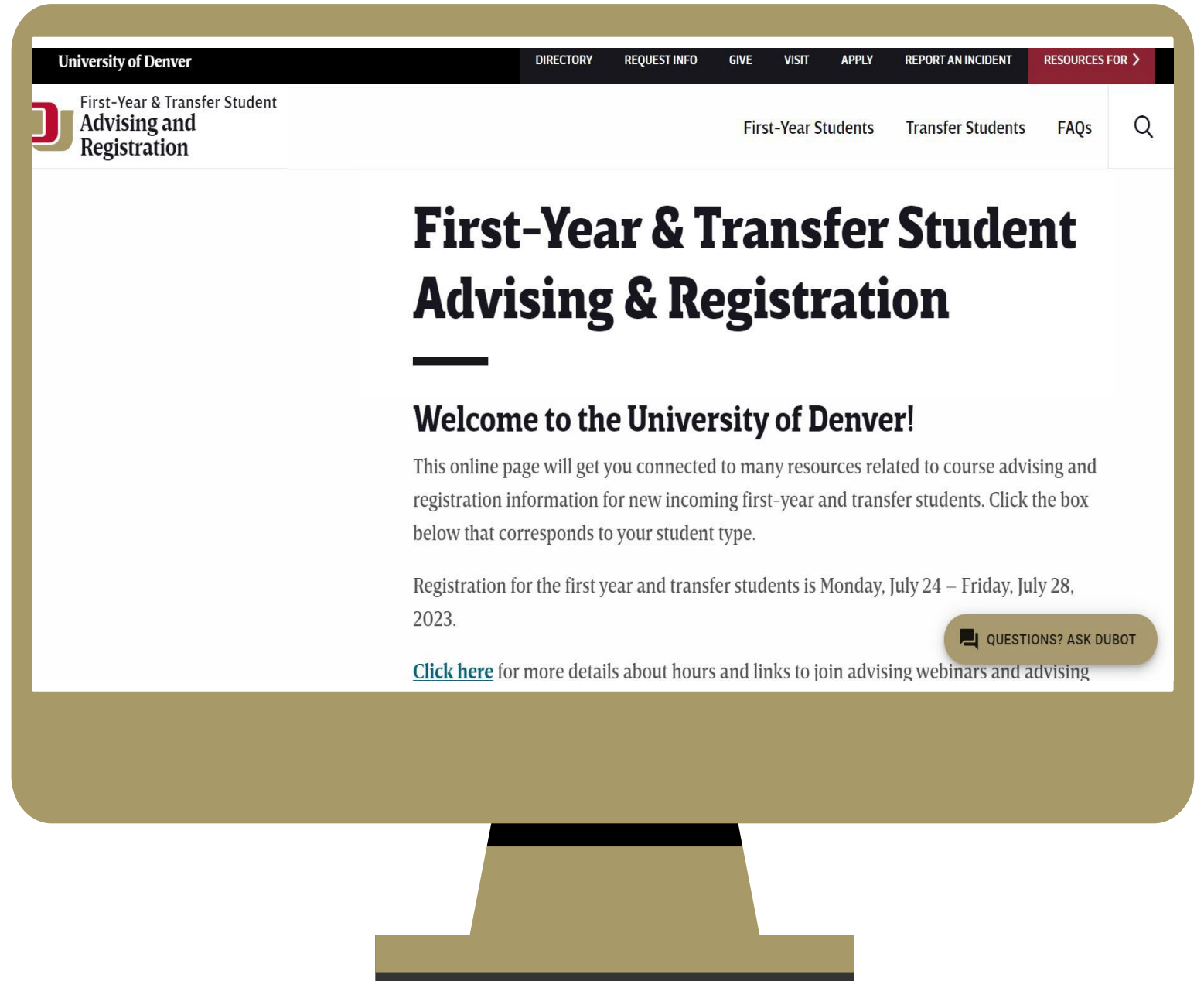
Electives are courses that count toward your minimum credits for graduation and are not already counting toward other parts of your degree, such as Common Curriculum, major, or minor.

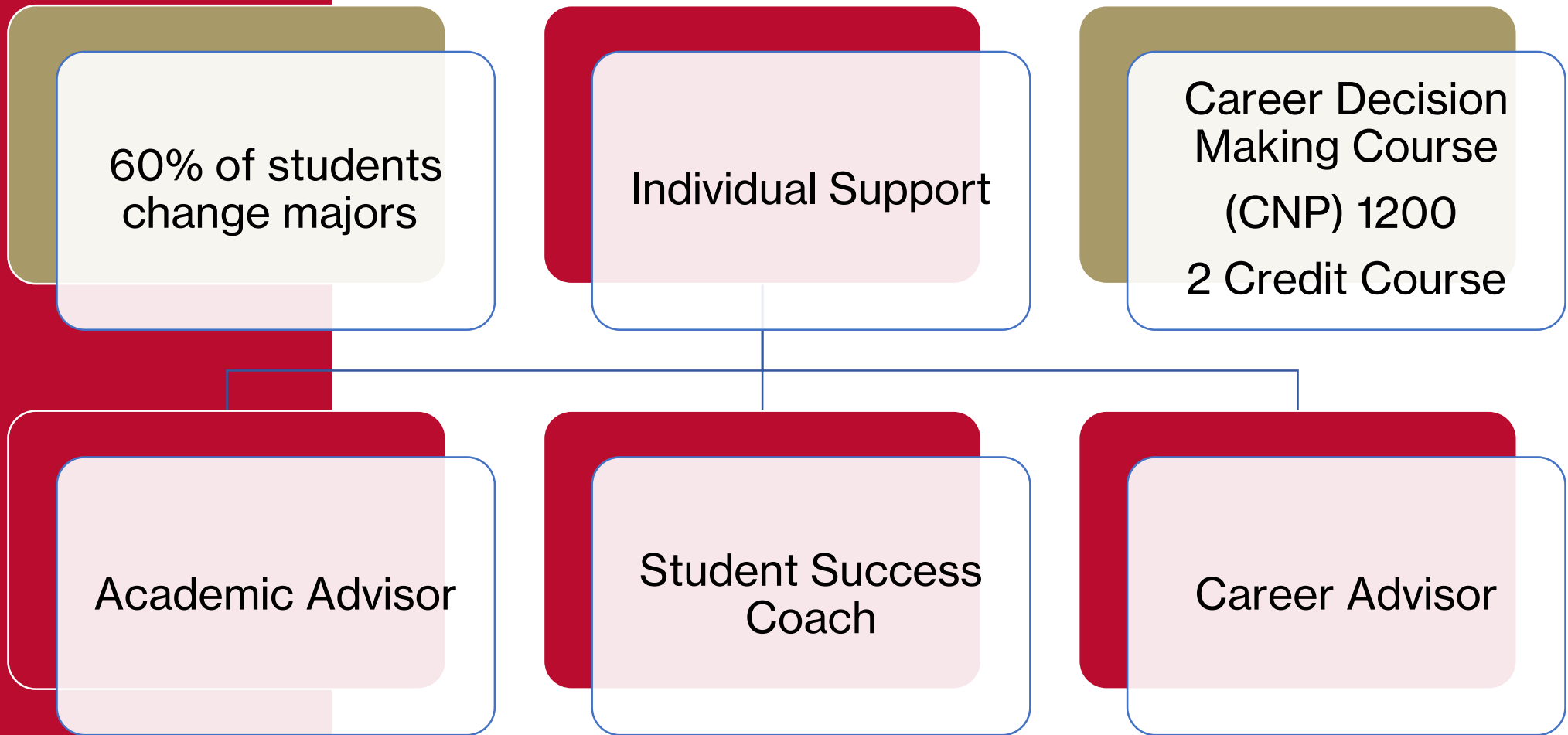
