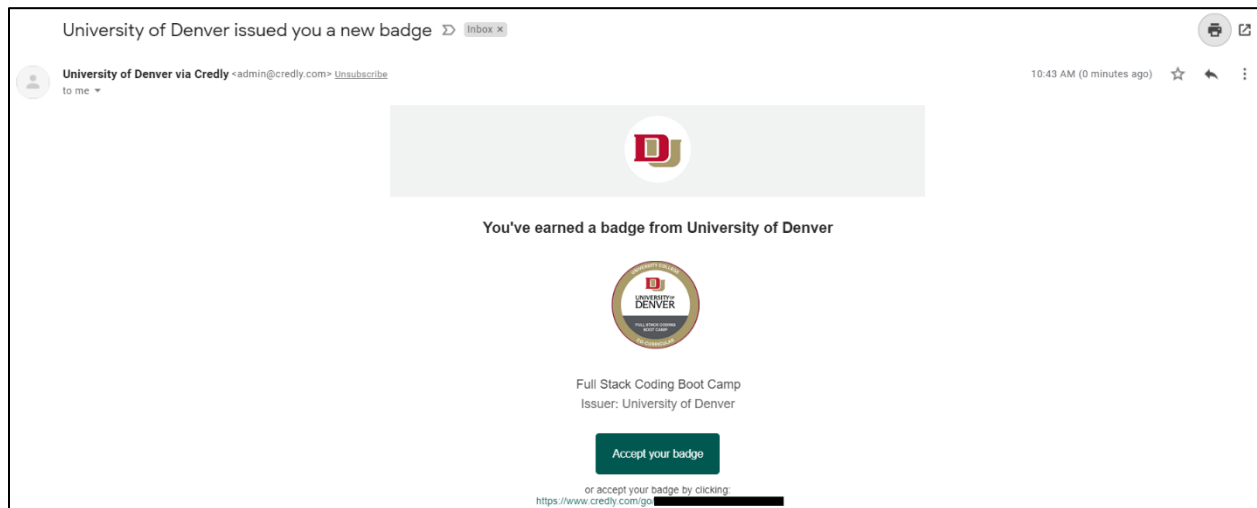


Tutorial – How to Accept DU Badges

Step 1: Badge Notification Email

When you earn a badge, you will receive an email from Credly that looks like this:

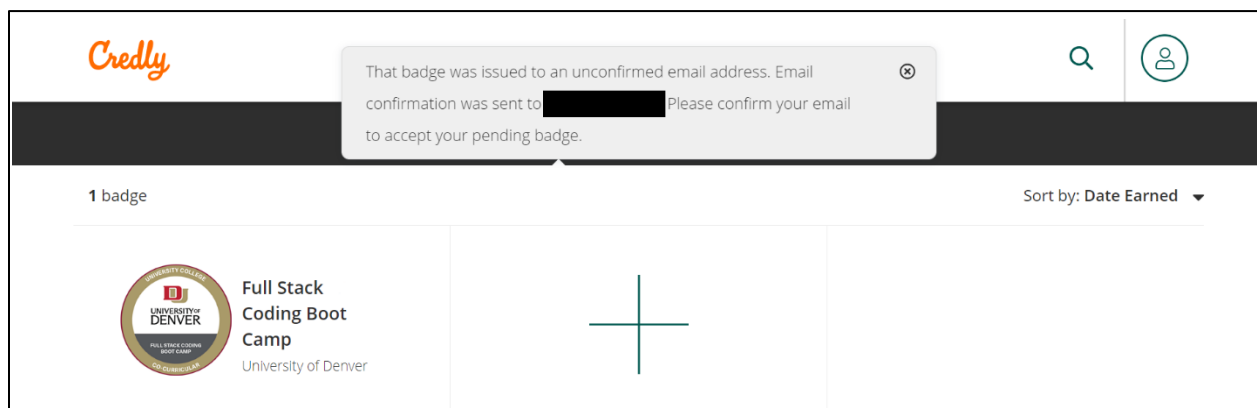


Click on the green **Accept Your Badge** button/URL to be taken to the Credly website. If you already have a Credly account and have set up your account to auto accept badges from an institution, the **Accept Your Badge** button and URL will be listed as **View Details** instead.

Please note: Badge notification emails are sent from admin@credly.com. If you are expecting a badge notification email and haven't received it, please check your junk or spam folder.

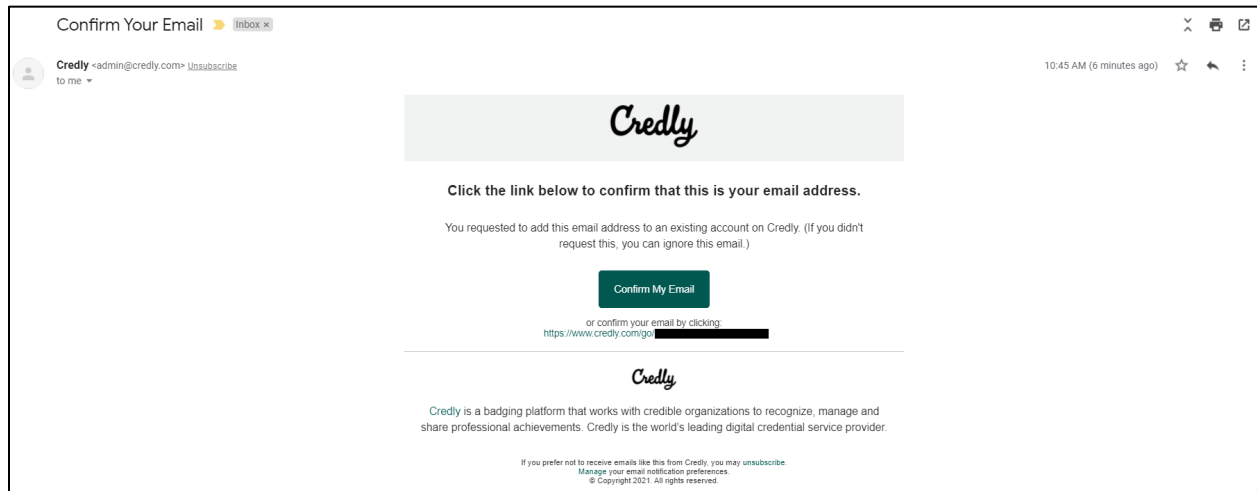
Step 2: Verify Your Email Address

After clicking **Accept Your Badge** in the badge notification email, you will be taken to the Credly webpage. In order to fully accept your badge, you will need to confirm your email address.



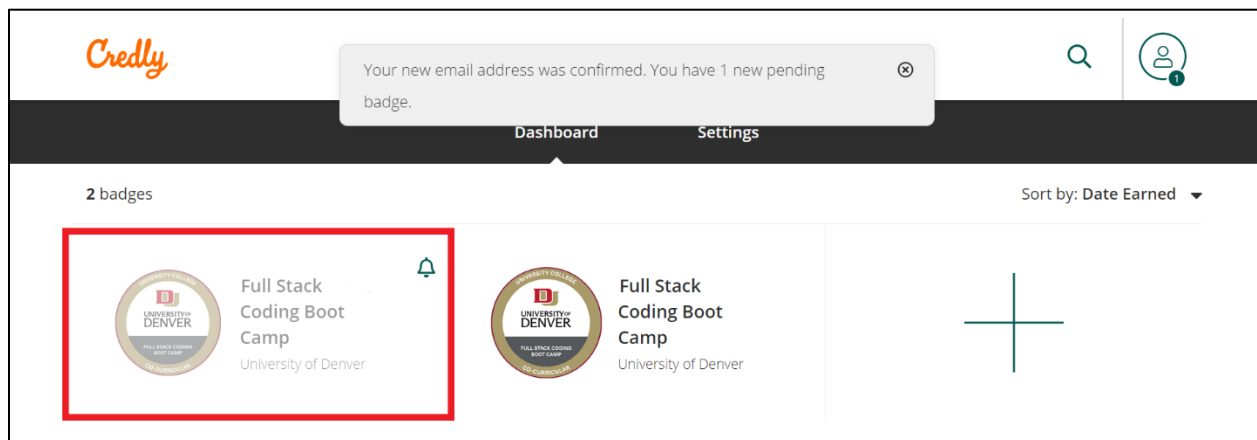

Check your email inbox for an email that looks like the message below. Select **Confirm My Email**.




Step 3: Accept Pending Badge in Credly

Your email address is now confirmed. Your pending badge will be grayed out on your Dashboard. Click the pending badge (highlighted in red).




