Additional Academic Weekend Information

KMC Agreement: All faculty and/or their department will be required to sign and adhere to their course specific KMC Internal Agreement.

Bus Departure and Arrival Locations: The bus will departure and arrive at the Mary Reed Circle on the DU Urban Campus. The bus will not wait past the designated departure time. Faculty are responsible for ensuring their students are on the bus.

Course/Classroom Locations: The KMC classroom locations are limited and will be determined based on group size, type of session, and space availability. Faculty are encouraged to utilize as much of the great outdoors as possible. The larger KMC indoor spaces such as the Dining Hall may be shared between multiple groups.

Food and Beverage: Menu's will be provided by the Kennedy Mountain Campus culinary team, Mountain Berry Culinary. All meals will be in the Dining Hall. All menus can be customized to adapt to special dietary needs including gluten and lactose free, vegan and vegetarian, 14 allergens free, or any other special situation. **Faculty must provide a roster with all dietary restrictions accounted for 14 days (about 2 weeks) before the event.**

Student Lodging: Students will be provided with a bunk in the Community Cabin of their choice, the selection criteria are below. **Faculty must provide a roster with all cabin selections accounted for 14 days (about 2 weeks) before the event.**

- Female Cabin
- Male Cabin
- Gender Neutral, Gender Non-Binary, and LGBTQ Cabin

Faculty Lodging: Faculty will be provided with a single bed in the four-person Homestead Cabins.

Outdoor Activities: The Outdoor Experience team curate's activities and programs based on the season and weather conditions. Examples of our safe and enjoyable experiences include rock climbing, via ferrata, guided hikes, team building exercises, and high ropes challenges. Please note, outdoor experience activities are drop in and first come first serve. Multiple courses will be on site participating in the outdoor activities.

Self-Guided Activities: All groups are encouraged to take advantage of the Kennedy Mountain Campus trails. Maps and additional information can be found at the Welcome Center in the Dining Hall.

Evening Activity/Academic Sessions: Locations for faculty led evening academic session will be determined based on group size, type of session, and space availability.

Evening activities open to all students:

- Recreation Room @ the Activity Center, all games are subject to availability, and outdoor equipment is subject to weather
