

### CAMPUS SAFETY ALERT

**Nature:** Motor Vehicle Thefts

Date of Incident: March 28, 2024

Location of Incident: Centennial Towers

#### Synopsis:

On Thursday, March 28<sup>th</sup> at approximately 11:25 PM, a Campus Safety Communication Technician witnessed an active theft of an electric scooter outside Centennial Towers using our video camera system. Campus Safety Officers were dispatched to the area, and they were able to locate and apprehend one of the suspects and recover one stolen electric scooter with the assistance of the Denver Police Department, who made the arrest. The arrestee reported there were two additional suspects he was working with that remained at large. Those suspects had stolen a second electric scooter outside Centennial Towers confirmed by Campus Safety as occurring on the same night at 11:12 PM. The arrestee also reported they had stolen two other electric scooters, and Campus Safety has not yet determined the location of those electric scooter thefts. The suspects cut the locks securing these electric scooters with heavy duty bolt cutters.

Campus Safety is sending this alert since electric scooters are considered motor vehicles under the Clery Act, and we believe these thefts represent a continuing threat to our campus community. #### **Safety and Security Tips:**

Victimization is never the fault of the survivor. These are some safety and security tips that could aid in reducing risk:

- 1. If you see suspicious behavior, call 911 or X13000 (303-871-3000) if on campus.
- 2. Do not attempt to confront individuals in the act of a crime, call 911 or X13000 (303-871-3000) instead to report it.
- 3. Park in well-lit areas.
- 4. Consider purchasing and using a vehicle alarm with ignition cut off switch or a steering wheel immobilization device
- 5. Use a U-lock to secure your electric bicycles and electric scooters.
