Synopsis:

On Friday, September 20th at approximately 12:20am, the Campus Safety Communications Center received a call of an in-progress theft of an electric bicycle on the east side of Carousel Apartments, and Campus Safety Officers were immediately dispatched to the area. The officers were able to locate and apprehend the suspect and recover a stolen electric scooter and electric bicycle with the assistance of the Denver Police Department.

Campus Safety is sending this alert pursuant to the Clery Act. Electric scooters and electric bicycles are considered motor vehicles, and we believe these thefts represent a continuing threat to our campus community. Within the last month, Campus Safety has received reports of the following motor vehicle thefts across the campus.

Safety and Security Tips:

Victimization is never the fault of the survivor. These are some safety and security tips that could aid in reducing risk:

1. If you see suspicious behavior, Call 911 or X1-3000 (303-871-3000) if on campus.
2. Do not attempt to confront individuals in the act of a crime, call 911 or X1-3000 (303-871-3000) instead to report it.
3. Park in well-lit areas.
4. Consider purchasing and using a vehicle alarm with ignition cut off switch or a steering wheel immobilization device. If you own an electric bicycle or electric scooter, consider using a bike alarm.

5. Use a U-lock to secure your electric bicycles and electric scooters. Consider using more than one lock on separate anchor points.
