Location of Incident: Peter Barton Lacrosse Stadium – 2240 Buchtel Blvd

#### **Synopsis:**

On Saturday, November 2<sup>nd</sup> at 1:53 PM, Campus Safety received a report the men's lacrosse team locker room at the Peter Barton Lacrosse Stadium had been burglarized. Campus Safety was able to locate the male suspect on camera breaking into the locker room using burglary tools between 10:21 PM and 11:02 PM on Friday, November 1<sup>st</sup>. A photo of the suspect is provided below.

Campus Safety is sending this alert pursuant to the Clery Act. The suspect in this criminal act was not apprehended and could pose a continuing threat to our campus community.
