- **NA***: Indicates a change in statistical organization from one AY to the next.
- **Academic Actions**: Those outcomes/sanctions assigned by faculty members/units/departments in response to violations of Academic Misconduct.
- **Warning**: The student was notified that their behavior was inconsistent with University expectations.
- **Probation**: The student was informed that further violations during the probationary period may result in suspension or dismissal from the University.
- **Deferred Suspension**: The student has been issued a suspension, but has been allowed to defer the effective date in agreement to complete assigned outcomes. Further involvement in behavior contrary with University expectations will result in the suspension being effective immediately.
- **Suspension**: The student has been required to leave the University for a period of time, usually no less than one (1) academic term and typically no more than three (3) academic terms.
- **Dismissal**: The student has been required to permanently leave the University.
- **Case Unique Outcomes**: Refer to actions or assignments required for a student to complete specific to their unique situation; often created in collaboration with the student.
